ACCURATE



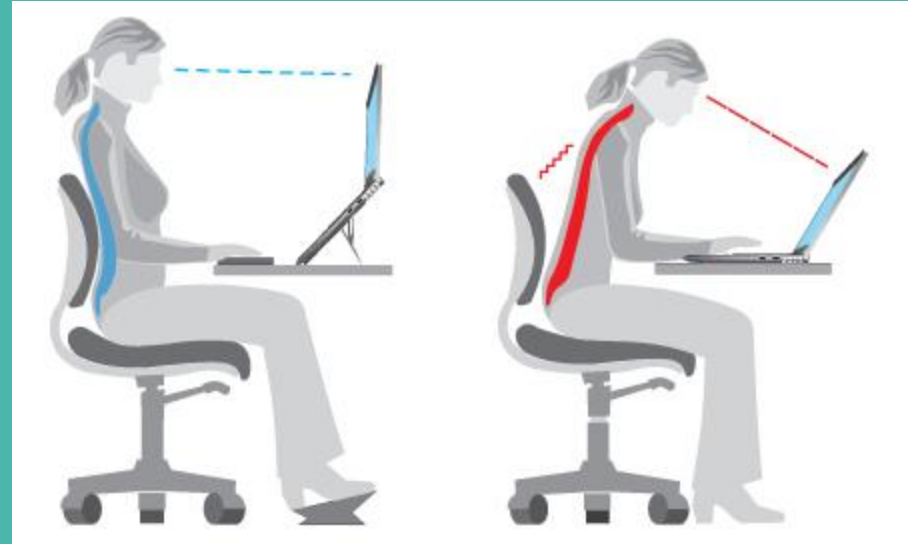
ENERGETIC *ADJECTIVE*
