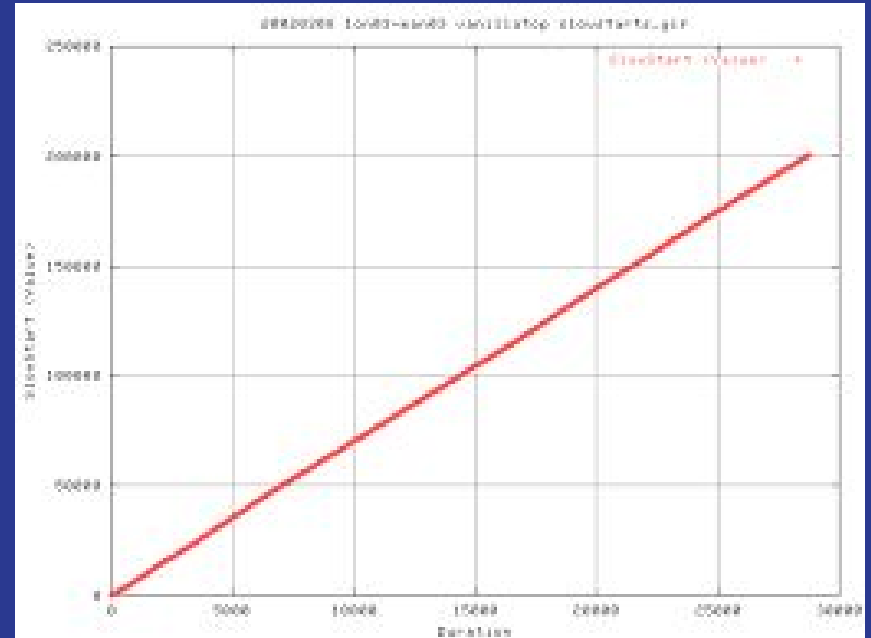

**STARE, STATUS = TO STAND, STAND
SOMETHING UP**

Stare and status will show up in words as **STAN**
or **STAT**.

HAPPENING IMMEDIATELY



REINSTATE

VERB

TO BRING BACK INTO
EXISTENCE OR AUTHORITY



INCONSTANT *ADJECTIVE*

NOT LASTING; NOT STEADY



ROOT: THESIS AND THETOS

THESIS = PLACING,

THETOS= HAVING BEEN PLACED

Thesis and thetos will show up in words as **THES**
and **THET**.

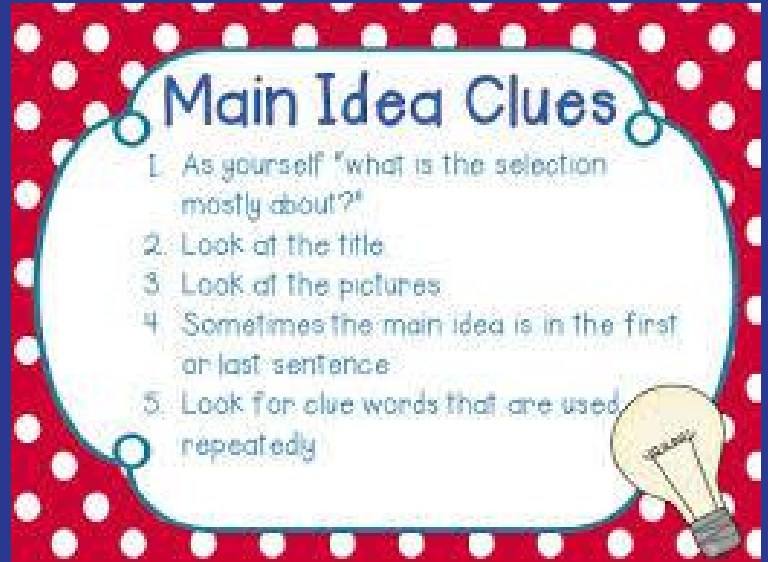
