TO PROTECT FROM OUTSIDE
INFLUENCE



ROOT: IDIOS

IDIOS = SINGLE, PECULIAR, PERSONAL

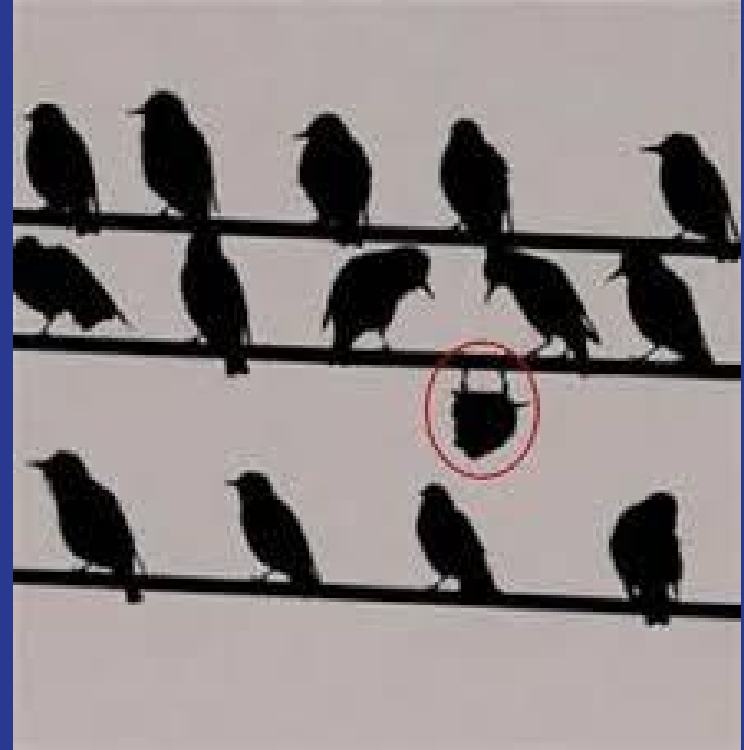
Idios will show up in words as **IDIO**.

NOUN

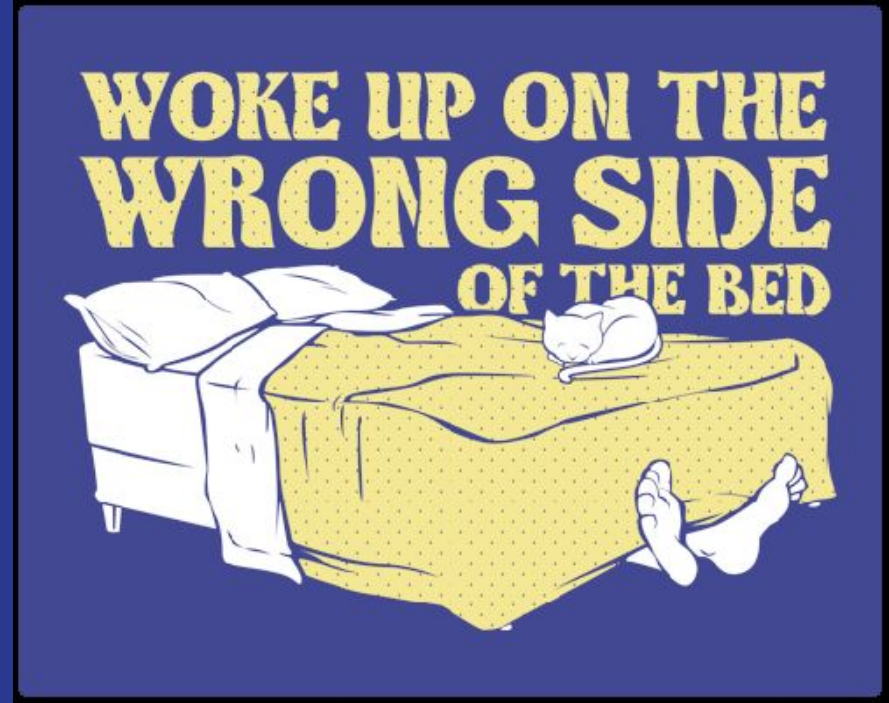
A PECULIAR QUALITY; A QUIRK



IDIOM

NOUN

SPEECH OR PHRASE SPECIFIC
TO A PARTICULAR LANGUAGE
OR GROUP OF PEOPLE



ROOT: NUMERARE, NUMERATUM

NUMERARE, NUMERATUM = TO COUNT

Numerare and numeratum will show up in words as **NUM**.

VERB

TO LIST SEPARATELY; TO
COUNT OFF

1. An item

2. Another item

3–4. Two items combined

5. Another one

6–9. Four items combined

I An item

II–III Two items combined

IV The last item

ADJECTIVE

SO PLENTIFUL AS TO BE

ROOT: PLUS, PLURIS,

PLUS, PLURIS = MANY

Plus and pluris will show up in words as **PLUS**,
and **PLUR**.

ADJECTIVE

BAFFLED; CONFUSED



SURPLUS

NOUN

AMOUNT BEYOND
WHAT IS
NECESSARY



PLURALITY

NOUN

GREATER PART; MAJORITY



ROOT: SINGULUS

SINGULUS = SINGLE

Singlus will show up in words as **SING**.



SINGLE *VERB*

TO ISOLATE; TO CHOOSE



SINGULAR ***ADJECTIVE***

SEPARATED FROM OTHERS;
UNIQUE
